We are a 100 bed Medicaid Certified Facility that provides 24 hour nursing services. We invite you to come in and tour our facility.

Call Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. for questions or to arrange for an appointment for a personal tour.

- Our Social Worker will help with the application process and guide you through the necessary paper work. Admission is open to all, regardless of race, color, national origin, age, sex or handicap.
- Activity personnel develop and implement a therapeutic recreation plan for each resident. Therapeutic recreation addresses social, emotional and spiritual well- being of the residents. It may be an activity that is done with a resident, such as letter writing, or it may be done in small or large groups.
- The Dietary Department strives to provide nutritious meals following federal and state guidelines. Diets are liberalized and individualized to create a home like experience. Alternate meals are always offered to allow the resident choices. Family members are welcomed to join their loved one for our monthly special meal, annual family picnic, or at one of our holiday dessert bars.
- Rehabilitation Services work diligently with nursing staff and physicians to maintain function and encourage mobility.
- Personal laundry is done by the Laundry Department and Housekeepers maintain cleanliness in homelike surroundings.
- Staff Development is continuous and on-going to help all employees stay current with health care changes. We have available optional therapies, such as Therapeutic Touch, Reiki, Aromatherapy and Sound Therapy; anything that helps our residents feel well is worth consideration.
